Objectives -

- Identify regurgitation and pulmonary stenosis in patients with repaired tetralogy of fallot and similar congenital cardiac malformations. Summarize the latest ideas and approach to surgical management. Describe interventional catheterization and transcatheter implantation of pulmonary valves. Interpret imaging of the right ventricle and develop criteria for intervention.
- Identify right ventricular arrhythmia.
- Develop appropriate criteria for choosing between medical therapy, catheter intervention and surgery in the management of right-sided heart defects to improve patient outcomes.

- Summarize the implications of new findings in cardiac genetics and development.
