
CARING FOR ALL

Our Training

Fellows participate in 13 consecutive four week rotations in a variety of practice settings. Faculty supervision is 1:1 on each rotation. Practice on-call duties are typically one night per week, with no in-house duties. Fellows typically have call duties two weekends per month.


Pediatric sessions, academic conferences, journal clubs and research opportunities provide a rich environment for expanding the fellow's knowledge basis and skill sets.
