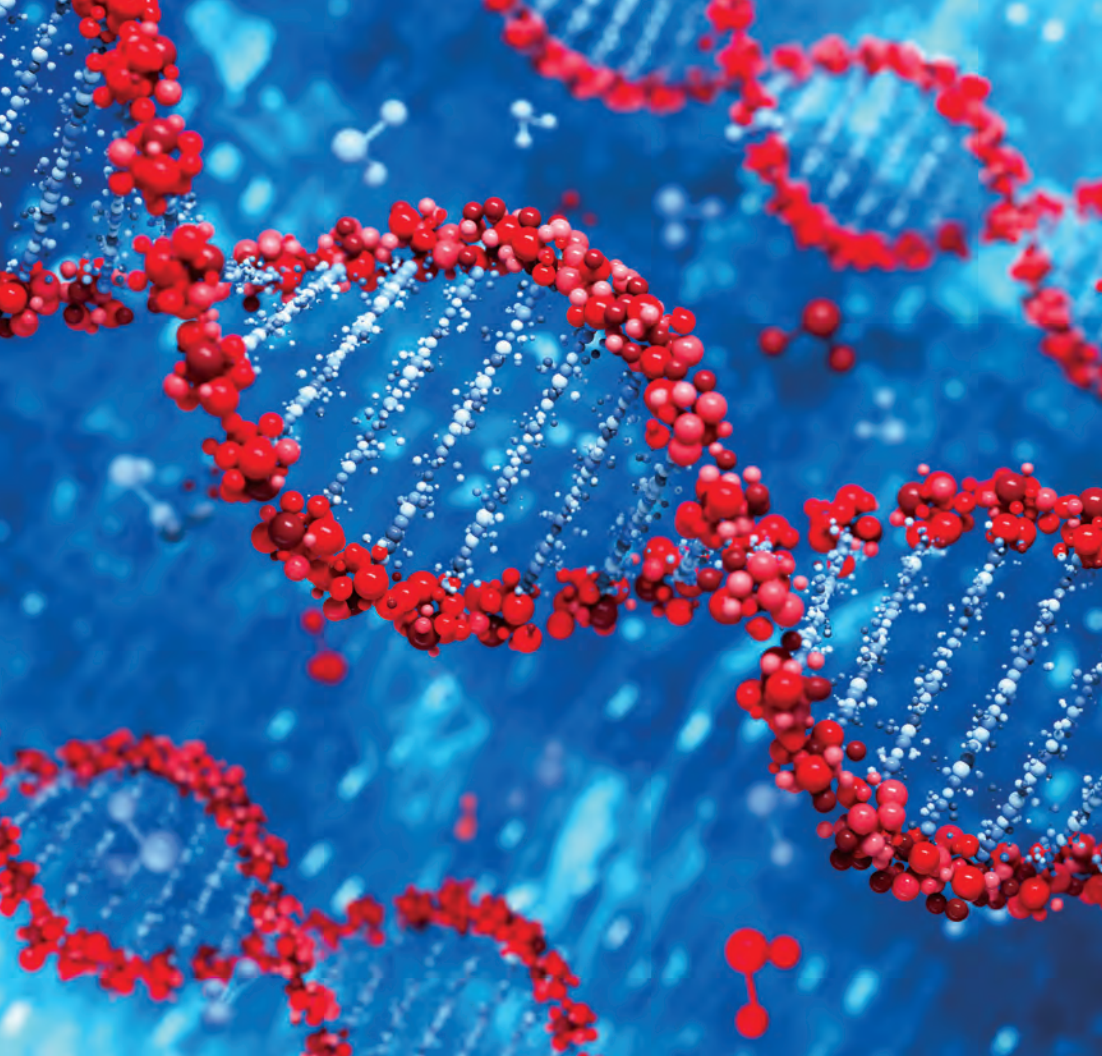
Because of you, Valerie found a partner in her child's doctor.

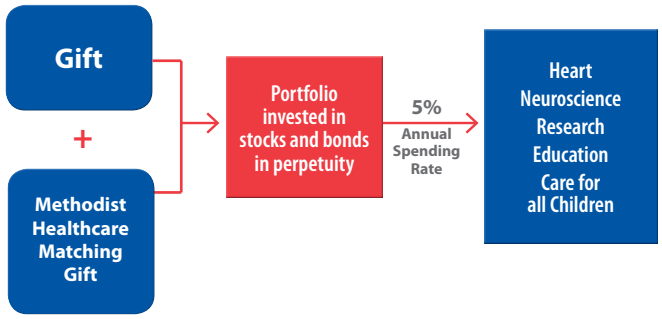

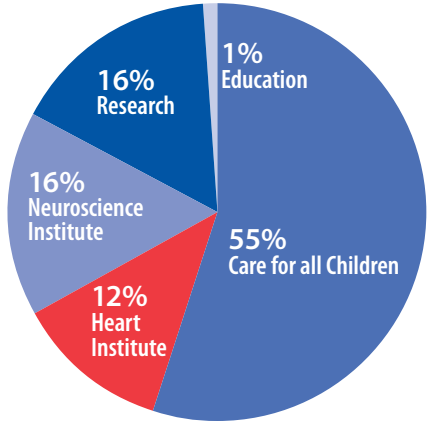
We believe kids aren't little adults. Because of support from donors, we have staff ready to help kids understand and cope with the uncertainties of being in the hospital.
