Halloween Safety Tips

Ten Tips To Avoid HALLOWEEN HAZARDS

1. Trick-or-treat early, while it is still daylight.
2. Have a partner or older child accompany youngsters.
3. Stay in your own neighborhood.
4. Don't cross the street when going house to house. Cross the street only at corners.
5. Parents should inspect all food given to children.
6. Throw away candy and food not commercially wrapped, or if wrapper appears to have been tampered with.
7. If food appears tampered with, contact the police.
8. Costumes should:
 - keep children warm and dry, in case the weather turns bad;
 - be short enough to avoid tripping while going up or down stairs;
 - include reflective tape if they are a dark color or if worn after sundown.
9. Masks should have large eye holes, allowing full vision, to prevent falls and other injuries.
10. When lighting pumpkins, use flashlights, not candles.
