PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

THE FACTS

Few children under age 10 can deal safely with traffic. Their age and small size puts them at risk. Actively supervise your children until they show you they can be safe pedestrians.

SAFETY TIPS

TEACH YOUR CHILDREN THE FOLLOWING RULES:

- Do not cross the street alone if you are younger than age 10.
- Never play in the street.
- Always try to walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks or paths, walk facing road traffic.
- Stop at the curb.
- Always look left-right-left both for danger before and while crossing the street.
- Walk - do not run - into the street.
- Obey traffic signals and crossing guards.
