Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Emergency Cash Assistance

TANF is a federal workforce development and employment program emphasizing work, training, and personal responsibility. Existing TANF customers receiving Families First benefits will be eligible to apply for this emergency cash assistance. Families can apply online for up to two months of emergency cash assistance if they were employed as of March 11, 2020 and they've lost employment or at least 50% of their earned income as a result of the pandemic. All TDHS offices are currently operating on appointment only as a precaution for COVID-19.
