Referrals are needed from MIFA in order to get help. For those that do this, on Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday, the charity offers a clothes closet & food pantry from 9am - 12pm. Applicants are first required to visit MIFA (910 Vance Avenue, Memphis, TN 38104) to get a food voucher and bring some form of ID to the food pantry (1325 Jefferson Avenue) to redeem it for groceries.
