

Hospital Checklist for Patient under Investigation for Coronavirus COVID-19 (Suspected or Confirmed)

- Assess exposure criteria <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-nCoV/hcp/clinical-criteria.html>
- See MOLLI document portal and search "Coronavirus: for resources. Also see MOLLI Infection Prevention Page (go to Safety and quality tab>Infection Prevention).
- If positive screen, IMMEDIATELY place surgical mask on patient call the local health department. For TN call TDH 615-741-7247. For MS call MSDH: 601-576-7725 or 601-576-7400 after hours).
- Place family/visitors in private room away from public.
- Obtain PPE/cart: gown, N95 masks, eye protection (such as goggles, face shields); surgical masks (for patient transport), gloves
- For patient transport within the hospital, place surgical mask on patient. Ensure correct placement of mask on the patient
- Patient Room
 - Ensure appropriate donning/doffing of PPE for anyone entering room
 - Record name of anyone entering room
 - Restrict Visitors
- Consider Airborne isolation with private bathroom or bedside commode
- Clinical Director makes appropriate notifications including Infection Prevention (see below)
- Transport patient with surgical mask and cover to minimize exposure risks
- Clinical Director and Leader Notifications
 - Patient's Physician
 - ID Consult
 - Infection Prevention at your hospital
 - Local health department
 - Administrator on call
 - Respiratory Therapist
 - Radiology
 - Lab Director
 - Facilities Director
 - Case Manager
