

# POST GRADUATE YEAR ONE - RESIDENCY

**PGY1 Purpose Statement:** The PGY1 pharmacy residency programs build on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

## **Required Rotations 1 month each; 8 total**

Parenteral Nutrition Orientation  
Pediatric General Medicine  
Parenteral Nutrition Svc (2 mo., non-consecutive)  
Pediatric Critical Care  
Neonatal Critical Care  
Pharmacy Administration

## **Elective Rotations 1 month each; 3 total**

Infectious Diseases/Antimicrobial Stewardship  
Specialized Pediatric Service (i.e. neurology, ambulatory care, etc.)  
Emergency Medicine  
Oncology (off-site rotation based on availability)  
Cardiovascular Critical Care  
May repeat a required rotation based on availability
