PGY2 Purpose Statement: The Methodist Le Bonheur Healthcare PGY2 pharmacy residency program in pediatrics builds on PGY1 pharmacy residency education and outcomes to provide the resident with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes required to become a specialized clinical pharmacist in the area of pediatrics, especially the critical care settings. Residents who successfully complete the program should be able to achieve excellence as a clinician, educator, and scholar in pediatrics, as well as complete additional certification in the specialized area of practice.
