Le Bonheur Children's Medical Center

The Pediatric Rehab Clinic provides coordinated services to children with impaired mobility needing a multidisciplinary approach to access equipment, bracing, therapy and oral antispasticity medicines. The clinic also works with parents to make appropriate referrals to community resources, orthopedics, neurosurgery, neurology, neuropsychology, feeding clinic and speech pathology. The goal is to attain the maximum functional level for the child while minimizing complications to their disease.

Typical diagnoses that are candidates for the clinic include:

- Cerebral Palsy
- Spasticity
- Developmental Delay
- Prematurity
- Amputation
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Pediatric Stroke
- Hemiparesis
- Brachial Plexus
- And Others

Care is provided by specially trained staff including:

- **Physiatry (Dr. Robert Greene)**
- Physical and Occupational Therapy
- Social Work
- Clinic Nurse Coordinator
- Nursing
- Orthotics
- Seating Specialist

Children ages 12 months to 18 years are eligible for the clinic with referral from the primary care provider.
